Our Annual *Gingerbread* Fundraiser is back! It will be held on **Friday December 1st 2023**, at the 1912 Center in Moscow, Idaho. We are reaching out to new and past Gingerbread House Makers in hopes that you will help us make our signature fundraiser a fantastic success again this year.

In past years we have welcomed over 100 participants that viewed and bid on 15 houses donated by members of our community. Funds raised through business sponsorships, Gingerbread Silent Auction, entrance fees and raffle tickets are used to benefit the work we do here at ATVP. Our services include 24-hour crisis intervention; emergency, confidential shelter; medical and legal advocacy; emergency financial assistance; emotional support, support groups; child advocacy; and youth violence prevention programs, including our highly popular summer camps. All our programming is provided free of charge and without discrimination.

Gingerbread House Specifications and Important Dates:

- House bases should be approximately 12" x 16". Exceptions may be made for larger houses if you contact us in advance with the dimensions for approval.
- All bases should be made of sturdy material such as plywood or foam board. Remember, houses need to be transported home by the lucky winner of your creation, in addition, please bring a labelled box that fits your house.
- Electricity: If your house has lights, please use a battery pack. Electrical outlets in the area where the houses are displayed are limited.
- We prefer that the houses be all edible except for the bases and lights. If your house is not, please make note on this form or talk with staff when you deliver your creation.
- Houses must to be delivered to the **1912 Center, 412 E 3rd street, Moscow, ID 83843, on Friday December 1st between 3 pm and 5 pm** Contact staff in advance if this is a problem. The judging team will view houses promptly at 5 pm. The event and auction begin at 6:30 pm.
